The final report of Hockey Nova Scotia's Diversity and Inclusion Task Force identified costs as the most significant barrier to participation in hockey, and this was particularly so for many traditionally under-represented communities. Growing the game and making it more equitable and inclusive requires new ways to welcome participation from diverse communities.

This registration fee support is our assist in removing some of these barriers and keeping players of African descent and families in the game. Up to \$500 in support per player is now available.

If you have a child of African descent registered in minor hockey in Nova Scotia, you are eligible to apply for registration fee support.

The deadline for 2022-2023 applications is November 1, 2022.
